The Minutes of the meeting held on Thursday 9th February 2006 were then read, confirmed and signed as a true record.

Matters Arising

- 1 Tyres – Enquiries made through a local tyre dealer had established that the minimum costs involved in obtaining and fitting new rims to the tractor would be in the region of £1200 exclusive of VAT at least.
- 2 In the absence of the Treasurer of the Athletic Club who was enjoying an extended holiday no opportunity had arisen to establish whether the Athletic Club would provide the requisite funding.
- 3 Maintenance of Outdoor Nets – the opinion of M Tennick to be sought in relation to the need or otherwise for a work party.
- 4 Indoor Nets – Difficulties had been experienced in hiring net facilities in that Thornton Hall was as had been feared fully booked. Two reservations had been made at the Tenby Leisure Centre during March but due to the travelling distance involved no firm commitments had been made for April. Andrew Miller had made enquiries of his own and at least one Sunday session had been booked in Haverfordwest whilst Andrew was also investigation other options at that venue and at Pembroke.
- 5 The Hon Secretary reported that he had attended the forum held by the Pembrokeshire Groundsmen's Association on 16th February although he had understood little of what was being talked about during the same.
